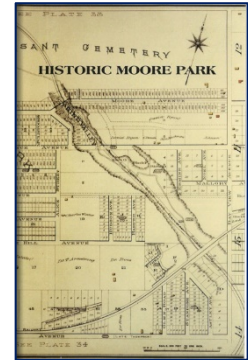


Welcome to Moore Park
