

The main objective of lawn bowling is to get as many of your bowls as close as possible to the jack (the small white ball). The game is similar in many ways to curling, but nicer because you are enjoying the fresh outdoors!

Why is lawn bowling so appealing?

- is a fun and strategic sport that is easy to learn
- is a very social sport and a sport for life
- it's for everyone, regardless of age, gender, cultural background or ability
- does not require physical strength
- does not require special equipment or clothing
- it's cheap
- · and has many health benefits.

Health benefits:

- mental health: enjoy the fresh outdoors and get some exercise in, helps to reduce stress and improve your mood and promote relaxation and goal setting
- muscle strengthening: improves flexibility, mobility and core strength, muscle toning, and balance while being a low impact exercise
- coordination and precision: concentration, hand, eye and foot coordination
- social heath: it can be enjoyed by everyone, of any age, gender or physical condition. Requires sportsmanship, communication, cooperation and teamwork.
